



## NJ March for Life

September 26 | Trenton

New Jersey's first March for Life is happening on September 26 in Trenton, starting with a Mass for Life at 9:30 am at the Cathedral of St. Mary of the Assumption, celebrated by Cardinal Joseph W Tobin, CSsR, with Bishop David M. O'Connell, CM, Bishop of the Diocese of Trenton, as homilist. The rally will follow at 11 am outside the Statehouse Annex on West State Street. The march will take place at noon and will consist of a one-mile loop through Trenton, followed by a return to the State House Annex. A concert will also be held at 10 am.

### How to get there:

...the Respect Life Office will not be providing busing. Carpooling is encouraged, and the Respect Life Office will coordinate some carpooling. Email [cheryl.riley@rcan.org](mailto:cheryl.riley@rcan.org) if you are seeking or offering carpooling options. Due to street closures, access to the State House garage and metered on-street parking on West State Street will not be available. If you are arriving by car or carpool, please park in one of the pay lots located near the State Annex and cathedral, such as the ones on Warren Street, East Front Street, and South Broad Street. Rates are \$9 for up to four hours and \$12 for up to 12 hours. The walking distance between the Cathedral of St. Mary of the Assumption and the State Annex is about nine minutes.

If you do not have the Listen Everywhere app installed on your phone, download it from the App Store/Play Store. If you already have the app, skip to step 3. (Scan the **Dynamic QR code** for assistance if necessary.)

3

Once the Listen Everywhere app is installed and you have verified you are connected to the WiFi network, scan the **Dynamic QR code** again. You will now be connected to the audio server.

Press the play button by pressing on the available audio channel.

5

Plug in your personal set of earphones or pair your earbuds via bluetooth to your device before Mass begins. \*Be sure that your earphones or earbuds are not disconnected during Mass.


