Stewardship Reflections...


"Therefore, stay awake, for you know neither the day nor the hour." - Matthew 25:13

Dear Friends:

In this season of All Souls, we continue our parish observance of STEWARDSHIP – THINK, PRAY – ACT. This second of the three weeks, we are focusing on PRAY.

As followers of Jesus, he gave us great example in the Lord's prayer, but exactly what is prayer?

In short, prayer is spiritual communication between us and God, a two-way relationship in which we should not only talk to God but also listen to God. Prayer to God is like a child's conversation with his/her parent. It is only natural for a child to ask his parents for the things needed.

There are many promises in God's Word to encourage us to pray, such as:

He shall call upon me and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him. (PSALM 91:15);

And it shall come to pass that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear. (ISAIAH 65:24);

Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. (MATTHEW 7:7).

The Scriptures tell us that we are to pray for one another, and they assure us that God hears and answers our prayers.

At baptism each of us has been re-configured to Christ, having received Christ into our heart. At that moment, we become a child of God and have the privilege of talking to Him in prayer at any time about anything. Our Christian life is a personal relationship to God through Jesus Christ. And best of all, it is a relationship that will last for all eternity.

In our prayer, we seek, among other things, to become holy. Therefore, all the faithful of Christ are invited to strive for holiness and perfection. Indeed, we have an obligation to so strive. Prayer cautions us to let neither the use of the things of this world nor attachment to riches hinder us in our quest for perfect love. Especially in November as we pray for All Souls, we are keenly reminded that the things of this world pass away, as do we, but our relationship with God is eternal and lasts forever.

WE HAVE BECOME STEWARDS OF THIS MESSAGE. Below are some questions that can help us think more carefully how we can position our parish to spread this Good News and encourage people to grow in their relationship with God through prayer.




How do we hear our CALL TO HOLINESS?
